

VICE-RECTOR FOR DEVELOPMENT AND COOPERATION WITH BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY (R₃)

1. The scope of duties and responsibility of the Vice-Rector for Development and Cooperation with Business and Industry results directly from the provisions contained in this document, the Senate resolutions and Rector's ordinances regarding the area of activity of the Vice-Rector for Development and Cooperation with Business and Industry, as well as in authorizations granted by the Rector.
2. The Vice-Rector for Development and Cooperation with Business and Industry fulfills the assigned duties in compliance with the provisions contained in the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science, the Act of 27 August 2009 on Public Finance, the Act of 17 December 2004 on Liability for Breaching Public Finance Discipline, the Statutes and Principles of Financial Management of Poznan University of Technology.
3. The main scope of responsibility of the Vice-Rector for Development and Cooperation with Business and Industry includes:
 - A) activity aimed at the University's development,
 - B) activity centred on innovation, investment and technology transfer,
 - C) informational and promotional activity of the University,
 - D) cooperation with industry and business,
 - E) activity related to ensuring equality and respect for the rights of employees, Ph.D. students and students.
4. The Rector serves as the direct superior of the Vice-Rector for Development and Cooperation with Business and Industry. The Rector may extend, change or specify the scope of the Vice-Rector's duties presented in this document.
5. The Vice-Rector for Development and Cooperation with Business and Industry represents the University in external relations in the scope specified in point 3, as well as in the scope of authorizations granted by the Rector.
6. The Vice-Rector for Development and Cooperation with Business and Industry performs the assigned duties directly or through the Deans, Directors and Heads of organizational units of Poznan University of Technology, in particular, supervising the work of: the Public Relations Office (R₃I), the Development Office (R₃D), the Equality Office (R₃W), the Careers Service Centre (R₃P), the Student Broadcasting Station of Poznan University of Technology (R₃R), the Centre for Technology Transfer (R₃C), and the Academic Business Incubator (R₃A).
7. The Vice-Rector for Development and Cooperation with Business and Industry is responsible, in particular, for:
 - A) *in terms of the activity aimed at the University's development:*
 - 1) giving opinions on the operational plans and the budget plan of R₃D,
 - 2) substantive supervision and supervision of the financial discipline of R₃D;
 - B) *in terms of the activity centred on innovation, investment and technology transfer:*
 - 1) disseminating achievements and research results of the University's employees and units,
 - 2) giving opinions on the operational plans and the budget plan of R₃P, R₃C and R₃A,
 - 3) substantive and financial supervision of R₃P, R₃C and R₃A;
 - C) *in terms of informational and promotional activity of the University:*
 - 4) giving opinions on the operational plans and the budget plan of R₃I and R₃R,
 - 5) substantive supervision and supervision of the financial discipline of R₃I and R₃R;
 - D) *in terms of cooperation with industry and business:*
 - 1) disseminating research achievements and opportunities of the University's employees and units,
 - 2) creating a club of partners supporting the University's development,
 - 3) cooperating with enterprises and business circles of the Wielkopolska Region;
 - E) *in terms of ensuring equality and respect for the rights of employees, Ph.D. students and students:*
 - 1) providing support for people with disabilities,
 - 2) supervising equality-related initiatives,
 - 3) supervising the execution of the financial plan of R₃W.
8. The Vice-Rector for Development and Cooperation with Business and Industry chairs or participates in the work of committees or teams as agreed by the Rector.
