



Resolution No. 101/2024–2028
of the Senate of Poznan University of Technology
of 22 April 2026

on the rules for admission to studies at Poznan University of Technology of winners and finalists of central-level olympiads and winners of international and national competitions in the academic year 2030/2031

Acting pursuant to Article 70(6) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), the following **is hereby resolved**:

§ 1

Without undergoing the qualification procedure (this does not apply to exemption from the assessment of artistic aptitude – a drawing examination for the following programmes: Architecture, Architecture [English track], and Interior Design), winners and finalists of central-level olympiads as well as winners of international and national competitions shall be admitted to the first year of first-cycle studies, in accordance with the annex to this Resolution.

§ 2

1. *The basis for obtaining the status of a winner or finalist shall be a certificate issued by the organising committee of the given olympiad or competition.*
2. *The entitlements referred to in § 1 may be exercised by winners or finalists only once, in the year in which the school-leaving certificate is obtained.*

§ 3

The provisions of this Resolution shall enter into force for admissions for the academic year 2030/2031.
