



Resolution No. 90/2024-2028
of the Academic Senate of Poznan University of Technology
of 25 March 2026

on expressing an opinion on the legitimacy of a motion
for the Prime Minister's Award

Acting pursuant to § 7 section 4 point 1a) of the Regulation of the Prime Minister of 15 July 2024 on the criteria and procedure for granting the Prime Minister's awards and a motion template for it (Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1099), the Senate **deems it justified and supports** the motion submitted by the Rector of Poznan University of Technology to grant Izabela Klapiszewska, Ph.D. in Architecture, the Prime Minister's award for an outstanding doctoral dissertation: "The impact of the type of zinc oxide and the method of its dispersion as factors determining the physicochemical and antimicrobial properties of cementitious composites" (discipline - engineering and technical sciences; civil engineering, geodesy and transport).
