

Regulations
Governing the Award of the Medal
“Distinguished Graduate of Poznan University of Technology”

§ 1

The “Distinguished Graduate of Poznan University of Technology” Medal, hereinafter referred to as the “Medal”, is an honorary distinction awarded to graduates of Poznan University of Technology.

§ 2

The design and description of the Medal are set out in the attachment to the Statute of Poznan University of Technology.

§ 3

1. The Medal may be awarded to a person distinguished by outstanding academic performance and student activity who:
 - 1) has completed a second-cycle degree programme at Poznan University of Technology;
 - 2) has obtained, during the second-cycle degree programme, an overall grade point average of at least 4.7 (calculated in accordance with the Study Regulations for First- and Second-Cycle Degree Programmes at Poznan University of Technology);
 - 3) has been awarded the final classification of very good with distinction for the second-cycle degree programme.

In awarding the Medal, consideration shall also be given to such criteria as: prizes won in competitions during first- and second-cycle degree programmes, authorship or co-authorship of academic publications, research and development as well as implementation activities, presentations delivered at academic seminars or conferences, and other achievements and accomplishments, including participation in student scientific societies and activities undertaken for the benefit of the academic community.

2. The supervisor, in consultation with the student, shall nominate the candidate for the Medal to the Dean.
3. A graduate nominated by the Dean who is not awarded the Medal may instead receive a letter of congratulations.
4. A nomination for the Medal may be submitted only once, in the academic year in which the graduate completes their studies.
5. The assessment guidelines are set out in Attachment No. 1 to these Regulations.
6. No more than five Medals shall be awarded each year.

§ 4

1. The Medal shall be awarded by the Rector upon the Dean's recommendation, following an opinion issued by the Medal Committee.
2. The Chair, Secretary and members of the Medal Committee shall be appointed by the Rector of Poznan University of Technology.
3. Meetings of the Medal Committee shall be convened by its Chair.

§ 5

1. The Dean shall carry out a preliminary selection and submit no more than three nominations to the Secretary of the Medal Committee by 15 September of the relevant academic year.
2. The application form for the award of the Medal constitutes Attachment No. 2 to these Regulations.

§ 6

1. The Medal shall be presented by the Rector of Poznan University of Technology during the ceremony inaugurating the academic year.
2. Recipients of the Medal shall also receive a monetary award in an amount determined by the Rector of Poznan University of Technology.

§ 7

1. The register of Medals awarded shall be maintained by the Medal Committee.
2. The list of graduates who have been awarded the Medal shall be made publicly available.

§ 8

These Regulations shall enter into force on the date of their adoption by the Academic Senate of Poznan University of Technology.
