Announcement to Members of the academic community of Poznan University of Technology

Due to the worsening of the pandemic situation in Poland and the introduction of further restrictions, in the period from 20 March to 9 April 2021, holding on-site classes, referred to in § 2 of the Rector's Ordinance No. 4 of 8 February 2021, will be suspended. Following the dean's decision, suspended classes may be postponed to a later date or continued in an online form.

In order to ensure safety, wherever it is necessary, the share of remote work performed in a rotational mode by non-academic staff can be increased.

All domestic and foreign business trips will be banned and previous consents issued for trips in the above-mentioned period are revoked.

The remaining provisions of the Ordinance remain in force.

At the same time, it is recommended that all staff, PhD students and other-cycle students exercise utmost caution in accordance with the distance-disinfection-face mask principle.
