



**Resolution No. 202/2020-2024
of the Senate of Poznan University of Technology
of 3 July 2024**

on granting consent to establish an internal scholarship fund

Pursuant to Article 420 of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2023, item 742, as amended), the Senate hereby **grants consent** to establish the Internal Scholarship Fund of Poznan University of Technology (hereinafter referred to as ISF PUT), intended for scholarships:

- 1) for international students and Ph.D. students;
- 2) for Ph.D. students of the Doctoral School;
- 3) for first-year students who are laureates of national or international subject competitions.

§ 1

1. The ISF PUT is created from sources other than those specified in Article 365 of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science, subject to the provisions of Article 420 Sections 4 and 5.
2. The ISF PUT may be increased through:
 - 1) allocations charged to the costs of educational and research activities,
 - 2) contributions from natural and legal persons.
3. The allocation may not exceed 20% of the planned net profit for the given year. In the case of profit:
 - 1) lower than planned – the allocation is proportionally reduced;
 - 2) higher than planned – the allocation remains at the planned amount.
4. No allocation may be made if it would result in a loss in the financial year.
5. Allocations made in a given financial year may be used starting from the following financial year.

§ 2

The detailed regulations for awarding scholarships shall be defined by the Rector in an ordinance.

§ 3

Resolution No. 49/2020–2024 of the Academic Senate of Poznan University of Technology dated 7 July 2021, on granting consent to establish an internal scholarship fund, is hereby repealed.

§ 4

This Resolution shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.
