

**Ordinance No. 38**  
**of the Rector of Poznan University of Technology**  
**of 28 July 2025**  
**(RO/VII/38/2025)**

**on organizational changes in central administration**

Acting pursuant to Article 23 of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), **it is ordered** as follows:

§ 1

The organizational structure of Poznan University of Technology, specified in Attachment No. 1 to Ordinance No. 25 of the Rector of Poznan University of Technology of 30 August 2024 (RO/VIII/25/2024, as amended) on the organizational structure of Poznan University of Technology, managerial duties and tasks of Vice-Rectors, Chancellor and Bursar, is changed as follows:

1. The Position of the Coordinator for Cybersecurity (RN), subordinated to the Rector, is created.
2. The Security Office (RN) changes its subordination to the Security Office (AB).
3. The Academic Guard of Poznan University of Technology (ASA) is created in the structure of the Security Office (AB).
4. The following sections are created in the Services and Operation Office: BMS and Lecture Halls Support Section, IT Support and Event Multimedia Services Section, IT Solutions Section.
5. The Finance Office (RK<sub>2</sub>F) changes its subordination to the Finance Office (RK<sub>2</sub>F).
6. The Deputy Bursar (RK<sub>3</sub>) changes the symbol to the Deputy Bursar (RK<sub>2</sub>).
7. The Project Settlement Office (RK<sub>3</sub>P) changes the symbol to (RK<sub>2</sub>P).

§ 2

The bidding diagram of the Organizational Structure of Poznan University of Technology is contained in the Attachment to the Ordinance.

§ 3

The execution of the Ordinance is entrusted, according to the competence, to:

- 1) the Chancellor,
- 2) the Bursar,
- 3) relevant central administration units.

§ 4

The Ordinance enters into force on the day of signing with effect from 1 August 2025.
